

PARENTS, DID YOU KNOW...?

This fall, when our grade 4 – 6 students completed the Tell Them From Me Survey, the concern of some students was there is a need for a safe way to report incidents of bullying. Many students tell their teacher, parent or other trusted adult, but some students fear retribution if they report bullying. In an attempt to address this concern, Landmark Elementary has recently joined *Stop a Bully*, an on-line bullying reporting system:



“**STOP A BULLY** is available to any student, at any school in Canada to report bullying and cyberbullying to school officials. **STOP A BULLY** is a registered charity which provides this national reporting service at no cost to all Canadian students and schools. Schools may also join as ‘member schools’ so that it is easier for their students to use the reporting service.”



PARENTS, YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD REPORT AN INCIDENT:

Go to www.stopabully.ca.

Click on **SUBMIT A REPORT** (among the top row of options).

As recommended, read the text carefully before filling out the report.

Click on

Fill out Incident Report

Upload images, particularly screenshots of cyberbullying evidence.

When you have completed the form, click on

✓ Submit Incident Report



The principal will receive an email notification with secure hyperlink, and will then begin an investigation. Reports will be saved and filed and the situation can be dealt with promptly.
